On September 22, 2003, the City of South Daytona entered into an interlocal agreement with the County of Volusia for the distribution of the 6-cent and 5-cent local option fuel taxes. That agreement is set to expire at the end of the month on August 31, 2020.

Earlier this year, the cities began negotiating with the County to adjust the distribution formula. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic negatively affecting fuel sales, it was decided by all cities that extending the existing agreement one additional year was prudent.

Attached, please find Resolution No. 2020-27 authorizing the Mayor to execute that one-year renewal. If approved, the renewal will be extended until August 31, 2021. This extension will give the sale of fuel time to stabilize so that we can adequately adjust the formula for future years.

All the cities in Volusia County are placing this one-year renewal agreement on their council or commission agendas this month for approval. The County is requesting that two original signature pages be forwarded to them before August 31, 2020 prior to the original agreement's expiration date.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH DAYTONA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A ONE YEAR RENEWAL TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS OF LOCAL OPTION FUEL TAX; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of South Daytona entered into an interlocal agreement with the County of Volusia for the distribution of local option fuel tax on September 22, 2003; and

WHEREAS, that interlocal agreement is set to expire on August 31, 2020 unless otherwise extended; and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to renew the interlocal agreement and its distribution formula for the proceeds of the 6-cent and 5-cent local option fuel taxes for one additional year.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH DAYTONA, FLORIDA, THAT:

- SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of South Daytona hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a one year renewal to the interlocal agreement for distribution of proceeds of local option fuel tax as requested, a copy of which has been attached to this document for reference.
- **SECTION 2. Repealer.** All prior resolutions, if any, which conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.
- <u>SECTION 3. Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution, or application hereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court, such portion or application shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or application hereof.
- **SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

### ONE YEAR RENEWAL TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS OF LOCAL OPTION FUEL TAX SEPTEMBER 1, 2020 – AUGUST 31, 2021

THIS RENEWAL AGREEMENT is entered into between the COUNTY OF VOLUSIA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, and the municipalities by which it is executed.

WHEREAS, the existing Interlocal Agreement governing the distribution of the local option fuel taxes expires on midnight, August 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to renew the Interlocal Agreement and its distribution formula for the proceeds of the 6-Cent and 5-Cent Local Option Fuel Taxes for an additional one year.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises above, and the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The Interlocal Agreement for Distribution of Proceeds of Local Option Fuel Tax executed on September 22, 2003, is hereby renewed for an additional one (1) year, beginning 12:01 a.m., September 1, 2020, and ending midnight, August 31, 2021.
- All other terms and conditions of the Interlocal Agreement are hereby ratified and continue in full force and effect.
- 3. This Renewal Agreement shall become effective if it shall have been executed by the County and by participating municipalities representing a majority of the population of the incorporated area of the County by August 31, 2020.
- 4. This Renewal Agreement may be executed by the parties in counterparts, and each counterpart shall be deemed an original.
