Re: Consideration of approving the annual BBQ and Bluegrass Festival Special Event Permit
Date: September 26, 2024

This is a request by the Parks and Recreation Department to allow outdoor entertainment in the form of live, amplified music as part of a special event (the third annual BBQ and Bluegrass Festival) proposed for 919 Reed Canal Road, (Reed Canal Park), South Daytona on Saturday, November 16, 2024.

The outdoor amplification request is in response to a special event permit application that was applied for on September 25, 2024. As part of the special event application, the applicant requested outdoor amplification by Evans Media Source, located internal to the site at the northeast corner of the subject property as shown on the applicants Special Event Application. The outdoor amplification is proposed for Saturday, November 16, 2024, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Section 5.6(A)(4)(i) Outdoor Amplification of the Land Development Code requires the use of any outdoor amplification including but not limited to live or recorded music, shall be in compliance with the City's noise regulations. Where amplified sound equipment is located within 1,000 feet of a residential area, the owner may apply for an outside amplification permit that shall be approved by the City Council.

The outdoor amplification is proposed at Reed Canal Park (919 Reed Canal Road), South Daytona within 1,000 feet of single family residential which requires Council approval. City staff will monitor the live entertainment in accordance with the required criteria of the Land Development Code, which requires compliance with the City's noise ordinance (Section 10-35, Outside Amplification permit).

In accordance with Section 5.6(A)(4)(i) Outdoor Amplification of the Land Development Code, and Section 10-35 of the Code of Ordinances, staff recommends the City Council approve the request for outdoor amplification proposed for 919 Reed Canal Road to be held on Saturday, November 16, 2024, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
