Kailynne Quartier, a beautiful 13-year-old, lost her heroic battle with brain cancer on July 16, 2007. Kailynne was the daughter of Retired Captain Doug Quartier, a 35-year veteran of our Police Department.

The South Daytona Lions Club is sponsoring this Memorial Ride as a fund-raising event, with the proceeds benefitting numerous local charities, programs, and foundations. The picnic lunch is a fund-raising event by the South Daytona Citizens Alert Council with proceeds going to support programs for First Responders.

The Ride will start at the South Daytona Police Department with Pre-ride registration from 8:00 AM – 9:45 AM. Sharply at 10:00 AM (kickstands up), the Ride will commence leaving the parking lot.
