### A. <u>SU 2021-22: 2355 South Ridgewood Avenue, Special Use for Child Care</u> <u>Center (Pre-school)</u>

This is a request for a Special Use by Lavernia Lock, 5 Stars Preschool Academy LLC, applicant, for a Special Use to allow a Child Care Center (Preschool) at property located at 2355 South Ridgewood Avenue within the Community Development Area.
