In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between any document forming part of the Agreement, the following order of priority shall apply: (i) first, any addendum or amendment to a quotation or purchase order which is executed by each of Watchfire and Buyer; (ii) second, Watchfire's quotation; (iii) third, these Terms of Sale; (iv) fourth, any other written agreement (including any "click through" agreement provided by Watchfire with respect to the Software (as defined below)); and (v) lastly, Buyer's purchase order accepted by Watchfire. For purposes of clarity, Watchfire rejects any and all modified or additional terms within Buyer's purchaser order.

Quotation. Quotation shall be valid for no more than forty-five (45) days from their date, unless otherwise stated in the Quotation. Buyer is obligated to review the Quotation carefully and to immediately advise Watchfire of any discrepancies or errors.
