Our existing contract for sports officials, scorekeepers and announcers expires this month. In anticipation of this expiration, staff followed our procurement procedures and went through the formal bidding process for these services.

In late January, staff requested bids for a contractor to provide sports officials, scorekeepers and announcers. Proposals were received until 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, at which time the submitted bids were publicly opened in the City Council Chamber Room located inside City Hall.

Sunshine State Officials Association provided the lowest responsible bid; therefore staff recommends awarding the Officials and Scorekeepers/Announcers Bid (Bid No. 24-B-002) to Sunshine State Officials Association as budgeted in the current fiscal year.

Once approved, the selected contractor will be required to submit a background check on all sports officials, scorekeepers and announcers that will participate in our sports program. An identification badge will then be issued to each participant in this contract to confirm to our parents with kids in our sports programs that a background check was successfully completed and reviewed.

BID FORM 9C: Drug-Free Preference Statement

<u>IDENTICAL TIE BIDS</u>. Preference shall be given to businesses with drug-free workplace programs. Whenever two or more bids, proposals, statements, or replies that are equal with respect to price, quality, and service are received by the city for the procurement of commodities or contractual services, a bid received from a business that certifies that it has implemented a drug-free workplace program shall be given preference in the award process. Established procedures for processing tie bids will be followed if none of the tied vendors have a drug-free workplace program.

In order to have a drug-free workplace program, a business shall:

- (1) Publish a statement notifying employees that the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited in the workplace and specifying the actions that will be taken against employees for violations of such prohibition.
- (2) Inform employees about the dangers of drug abuse in the workplace, the business's policy of maintaining a drug-free workplace, any available drug counseling, rehabilitation and employee assistance programs, and the penalties that may be imposed upon employees for drug abuse violations.
- (3) Give each employee engaged in providing the commodities or contractual services that are under bid a copy of the statement specified in subsection (1).
- (4) In the statement specified in subsection (1), notify the employees that, as a condition of working on the commodities or contractual services that are under bid, the employee will abide by the terms of the statement and will notify the employer of any conviction of, or plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, any violation of chapter 893 or of any controlled substance law of the United States or any state, for a violation occurring in the workplace no later than five (5) days after such conviction.
- (5) Impose a sanction on or require the satisfactory participation in a drug abuse assistance or rehabilitation program if such is available in the employee's community, by any employee who is so convicted.
- (6) Make a good faith effort to continue to maintain a drug-free workplace through implementation of Section 287.087, Florida Statutes.
