"Hometown High School Seniors" Eligible for Scholarship

About the Community Trust:

The Community Trust was created by the South Daytona City Council through the adoption of Resolution #06-02 pursuant to the guidelines prescribed by the Internal Revenue Service Code 501 (c) (3) as a not-for-profit charitable entity. The Community Trust was established exclusively for charitable, educational and other public purposes.

The purpose of the South Daytona Community Trust, Inc., Academic Scholarship, is to provide *"Hometown High School Seniors"*, i.e., high school students living in South Daytona as their permanent residence, with a financial award of \$1,500 to further their educational endeavors. The South Daytona Community Trust, Inc. Board of Directors believes that education is a large factor that determines the success of not only individuals, but also contributes to the greater success of our community. The Board also recognizes that students who actively participate in their community through volunteering add to the improvement of our City. This organization wishes to annually award a high school student that contributes to the City in a positive manner through volunteering and participating in charitable activities that enhance the community.

Scholarship Criteria

- Student must be a resident of South Daytona
- Student must be a senior currently enrolled in high school – home school included
- Student must show proof of acceptance into a college, university, or post-secondary school
- Student must show proof of community service with a school counselor signature.
- Student must have at least one high school teacher recommendation
- Student must write a 500-word essay titled "How Does Volunteerism Benefit My Community". The essay should be a word document, double spaced and include the applicant's name, address, high school name and phone number.

Scholarship Award

- Award amount: \$1,500 to be used for tuition, books or related educational expenses. The award will be deposited directly to the college or vocational school of the winning student
- The Community Trust Board of Directors will review all applications and essay submissions to determine scholarship award recipient.
- Submission due by April 29th 4:30 p.m. with the award announced at the May 10, 2022 Community Trust Board meeting.

Scholarship Purpose:

The purpose of the South Daytona Community Trust Academic Scholarship is to encourage students to actively participate in their community through volunteering and to further their educational endeavors. The South Daytona Community Trust, Inc. provides this opportunity for *Hometown High School Seniors* to be productive and add to the improvement of our City. This organization believes that education is a large factor that determines the success of not only individuals, but also contributes to the greater success of our community.

Scholarship Award:

The scholarship amount awarded will be \$1,500.00 to be used by the student for tuition, books or related educational expenses. One scholarship will be awarded each year. The awarded funds will be deposited directly into the recipient's account at their selected college, university or trade school.

Scholarship Submission Requirements:

1. Student applicant must be a resident of South Daytona for at least twelve (12) months to qualify. A copy of the student's valid driver's license must be submitted with the application. The scholarship evaluation committee will verify the residency requirement by reviewing the submitted driver's license and comparing it to utility billing records.
2. Student must be a senior currently enrolled in high school – home school included.
3. Student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (unweighted). An official transcript must be submitted with the application to verify GPA requirements.
4. Student must show proof of acceptance into a college, university, or post-secondary school.
5. Student must show proof of community service verified by a school counselor or parent if homeschooled. The demonstrated community service performed must be within the municipal limits of South Daytona.
6. Student must have at least one high school teacher recommendation.
7. Student must write an original, 500-word essay titled "How Does Volunteerism Benefit My Community". The essay should be a word document, double spaced and include the applicant's name, address, high school name and phone number. The required essay must be signed by the applicant to verify originality.

Scholarship Selection and Award:

All applications will be reviewed by City staff and a recommendation will be made to the South Daytona Community Trust Board of Directors for award. Evaluation criteria will include GPA, length of residency in South Daytona, community service achievements and the content presented in the required essay.

The award will be made at a regularly scheduled South Daytona Community Trust Board Meeting in May. All applicants will be notified if they were selected for award or not. The recommended applicant will be asked to attend the South Daytona Community Trust meeting to receive the award.

Scholarship Application Availability and Submission Deadline:

Applications are available at your school’s guidance counselor’s office or at the Office of the City Manager, South Daytona City Hall, 1672 South Ridgewood Avenue, South Daytona, Florida.
